

### **Description**

TP600 is a soft and flexible open cell polyurethane foam, impregnated with an acrylic based, UV stabilised resin. The resin is water repellent and contains a fire retardant. It is supplied as pre-compressed rolls with a self-adhesive side to aid initial location. Weather tight against the most severe combinations of wind and rain, it satisfies most expectations as an external weather seal for window perimeter seals and in building and civil engineering applications. With full BBA approval, the product has been extensively tested and has a proven reputation across both the UK and Europe. (Cert. 96/3309)

### **Application**

- After measuring the width of the joint and ensuring the total movement is within the capacity of the selected tape size, application may proceed.
- Remove outer release liner and the opening wedge at the start of the roll.




Fig. 1 Tape application at corners Note oversize length 10 mm/m Install small loop to ensure sufficient length

- If installing tape into a construction joint with a cross-joint, it may initially be applied either horizontally or vertically (from bottom to top to avoid stretching of the tape). However, when applying to a door or window frame the horizontal seals must be applied before the vertical ones (Fig. 1). Tape must be applied with the adhesive side to the frame when working with fenestration but may be applied in any order when working with construction joints. In both cases do not stretch the tape. When working in damp or cold conditions, if the tape is not adhering to the joint face, a suitable wedge should be used to hold the tape in position until it is expanded. Ensure the tape is recessed by a minimum of 2 mm into the joint. (Fig. 4).
- When calculating the length of tape to be fitted, add 20 mm/m to the actual joint length. Be sure to measure the opening and not the window.
- At the end of a roll, cut off the tape wedge finish. Repeat the
  process with a new roll, making a close compressed butt
  connection as shown in Fig. 2. At cross of crucifix joint, install
  as per Fig. 3.
- If the seal is to be tested using the CWCT (TN41) hose test, we recommend a minimum tape width of 25 mm. The tape should be allowed 7-10 days conditioning in the joint before testing.
- When installing TP600 between a window and a sloping sub-sill, the joint must be no more than 5° out of parallel. The TP600 should be applied to the 'level' face of the joint.
- When inserting the tape into a joint with difficult access or when making butt or corner joints, the use of a skewer inserted into the tape thickness close to the end of the length to be applied allows the tape to be more accurately located.
- When applying PU foam behind TP600, prior to application, ensure that the tape has fully expanded to seal the joint otherwise foam is likely to penetrate past the edge of the tape and will be visible on the external face.



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### **Please Note**

- TP600 is not suitable for locations where standing water or a head of water is likely to occur, eg under a window fixed on a flat topped sub-sill where the tape is not within 2-3 mm of the vertical face of the sub-sill.
- High temperatures accelerate tape expansion, while low temperatures delay this. At ambient temperatures above 20°C, the tape should be stored in a cool place on the construction site away from direct sunlight. A small fridge is ideal for this.
- Remaining rolls in opened boxes should be maintained in a horizontal state and weighed down to prevent lateral expansion (telescoping) of the rolls. Whilst it is unnecessary to seal over the external face of the tape, the exposed edge can be plastered or painted over. The compatibility of sealants must be tested. In some cases, white sealants can be incompatible. The tape must not come into contact with chemicals containing solvents or aggressive chemicals.
